

# 2015 VPS USER CONFERENCE

Virtual Pediatric Systems, LLC ("VPS") formed in 2002 with just 16 units and now supports over 120 ICU units. VPS specialties include comparative analysis, enhancing the quality of critical care and is the basis for numerous research publications. This consortium added Cardiac ICU patients in 2009 and now has over 100,000 cases. By May 2016, the VPS registry will reach the plateau of one-million cases.
